NB: these fees are not billed on your fee statement. Term fees for Instrumental Music lessons payable via the School Portal Online Payments. Fees for music lessons are non-refundable. Any changes to enrolment require four full weeks' notice prior to the commencement of each term.

Administration Fees:

School Fees:

These fees are calculated based on the recommendations of Brisbane Catholic Education. Included in this fee is an Archdiocesan Education Levy. This fee is remitted centrally to Brisbane Catholic Education, which provides shared resources to all schools within the Archdiocese. It also provides for the purchase of land for future school development within the Archdiocese. This is a vital investment in the future of schooling within the Archdiocese. The balance of school fees are used to cover the day to day running/maintenance expenses of the college.

School Levies:

School levies are used to provide resources and consumable items in the classroom, Sports, Diaries, ID Cards, Insurance and to support the provision of ICT and Library/Text resources. Senior School Levies for Yr11 & Yr12 may be higher based on subject choices. This levy also includes a limited provision for guest speakers, incursion and some excursions.

Capital Levy:

This is a compulsory levy charged per family. It is used to support the Capital loan repayments and minor capital projects for land and buildings. This levy is not tax deductible.

P & F Levy:

This levy is collected on behalf of the Unity College P & F Association. It is used to fund various projects around the school, improving facilities for students.

Additional Fees and Charges:

Where possible all additional fees and charges have been included, however there may be exceptional events/excursions where students may incur additional costs which will be charged on a user pays basis and will need to be paid in full before the activity takes place. This refers in particular to extra-ordinary activities such as surfing, netball, rugby, first aid courses, competitions, boat licenses, overnight excursions etc.

Discounts – Early Payment:

An early payment discount of \$50 will be applied to the account if the full years fees are paid in advance at the commencement of the year.

Discounts - Siblings:

In 2017, Unity College will continue to offer a discounted fee structure for families who also have students at another Catholic School on the Sunshine Coast. Please note the discount only applies to school fees. It does not apply to the Capital levy, P & F Levy or School Levies. Below is a table setting out the fee discounts as they apply to Unity College for 2017.

Payment Terms:

Payment for all school fees are due by the first Friday of the school term, unless you have an agreed payment plan in place with the Business Manager. Fees can be spread over weekly, fortnightly or monthly payments via direct debit from either the bank or credit card. Bpay facilities are also available for those who prefer internet banking. Fees can be paid direct to the office via cheque or credit card. Please refrain from sending students to college with large sums of cash that can easily get lost.

Failure to pay your account on time or make alternative arrangements with the Business Manager may result in your account being referred to our debt collection agency.
